For the 2019-2020 season, STAR 1 – 4 will continue to be assessed using Gold, Silver, Bronze and Merit assessments.

*Special Olympic Pair and Dance couples will pay \$35.00 per person. *Special Olympic Solo Dance entrants will pay \$70.00 per entry.

**Should it be necessary to eliminate entries due to a shortage of ice events will be eliminated in the following order. Pre-Novice Short, Pre-Novice Free, Juvenile U14 and Juvenile U12.



Entry fees will be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (December 19, 2019) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE TECH REP AND LOC AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. **Thursday, December 19, 2019**. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 9 of this announcement.

For all categories age, shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2019 and tests passed shall be as of December 19th, 2019 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

For event requirements, please refer to the 2019-2020 Skate Canada Technical Requirements Guides for Competitive and STAR posted on the <u>Technical pages</u> of the <u>Skating in BC website</u>.

Planned program sheets for all **artistic and free skate** events except star 1,2,3 & 4 must be submitted online to the BC Coast Region, Wufoo website, by **January 17, 2020.** Click <u>here</u> to enter planned program information.

There will be a \$25 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the January 17th deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>WinterSkate Competition</u> page of the BC/YK Section and on the <u>BC Coast Region</u> website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

NO tests will be offered at this competition

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles and artistic. If short and free programs are listed as separate events, skaters may enter one short program and one free program. Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile skaters may also enter a STAR 7 or 9 short program category in addition to the competitive category. Skaters choosing to enter more than one event including supplementary STAR events do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that are unable to be resolved.
- 2. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final.



3. Should there be only one entry in any event, the competitor may skate for an evaluation*, skate up one level, or withdraw and the entry fee will be refunded. If there is a last-minute withdrawal in an event that had only 2 entries, that same options apply for the remaining skater. *Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to competitive categories and STAR Free Skating Categories. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only.

Note that in BC Coast Region competitions, men and women will compete together in all STAR Supplementary Events other than Solo Dance events.

- 4. MARKING: Please see the STAR Technical Package on the Section website for the marking criteria for each of the STAR and Supplementary Event categories. Note that the lower levels are all assessed with ribbons awarded. Competitive categories are all marked in CPC.
- 5. WARM-UP TIMES:

STAR 2	3 minutes
STAR 3 -5	4 minutes
Star 6 to Gold Free Skate	5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile Singles	5 minutes
Juvenile & Pre-Novice Singles	6 minutes
Artistic	3 minutes
Special Olympic Singles and Pairs	5 minutes
All Pattern Dance categories	30 seconds without music followed by 2:30 minutes

The warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes at the discretion of the Referee. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

6. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

- ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1 must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- All ice dancers using Skate Canada Contemporary Music selections, or their own selection of pattern dance must also submit music electronically.
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration
 process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to Lori

- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Competitors must hand in their back up file either USB flash drive or DC at the registration desk at least one hour prior to when they are scheduled to skate. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB/CD.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
 - a. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.



- b. The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- c. Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- d. Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- 7. COACHES: In order to be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and have proof of coach registration & accreditation. Temporary accreditation will be issued by showing current Skate Canada membership and first Aid information for \$25.00 per day (payable to the BC Coast Region Coaches Committee).
- 8. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 9. AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.
- 10. **SCOTT ROBERTS MEMORIAL TROPHY:** This trophy will be presented to the Artistic Winner in STAR 3 Male and Female Categories. This award will be presented at the BC Coast Region AGM in April 2020. The winner will be notified the week following the competition.
- 11. **CAROL BLACKBURN MEMORIAL TROPHY:** This trophy will be presented to the winner in the Juvenile U14 Male and Female Categories. This award will be presented at the BC Coast Region AGM in April 2020. The winner will be notified the week following the competition. This award is sponsored by the Vancouver Skating Club.
- 12. There will be a photographer at this competition for official and action shots. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 13. <u>Protests: Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.



WinterSkate Online Registration & Planned Program Instructions

The BC Coast Region uses an online registration system with the company <u>Wufoo.com</u>. All registrations must be completed using this online system. <u>Online Registration</u> to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater but not to the primary coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. THERE IS SOMETIMES A DELAY IN THE SYSTEM BEFORE YOU ARE TAKEN TO THE PAYMENT PAGE. YOU **MUST** WAIT TO MAKE PAYMENT OR YOU **WLL NOT** BE **REGISTERED**. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is <u>not</u> necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.

There are NO refunds given after the closing date of entry unless the event is cancelled.
