Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (April 21, 2021) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER

Single Entries: All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only.

One Club Entries: If <u>all</u> entries in a category are from the same club, the skaters and coaches will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Skaters must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate if they wish to change categories or withdraw with a refund.

All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, April 21, 2021. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 6 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2020; tests passed shall be as of April 21, 2021 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL EVENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY SUNDAY, MAY 2, 2021. Click here to enter planned program information.

Note: there will be a \$25 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the May 2, 2021 deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to compete virtually until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>Victoria Day competition page</u> of the BC/YK Section website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website.

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in a category.
- 2. Should there be only one entry in any event, the competitor may skate for an evaluation only*, skate up one level, or withdraw and the entry fee for that event will be refunded. If there is a last-minute withdrawal in an event that had only 2 entries, the options apply for the remaining skater. *Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to competitive categories and STAR Free Skate categories. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only.
- 3. ONLINE VIDEO SUBMISSIONS-a separate document will be provided with instructions for the online video submission process. Videos must be submitted by May 5, 2021 at 11:45pm to the Dropbox link provided to each club.

4. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- All skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process. Registration will not be accepted without

- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- 5. AWARDS-information regarding awards will be sent out prior to the competition.
- 6. PROTESTS: <u>Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Tech Rep.
- 7. ASSESSMENTS: Assessments will **not be offered** at this competition .
- 8. WARM-UP TIMES(for filming of videos):

Pre-Juvenile 5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive 6 min

BC/YK SECTION Online Registration Instructions

Skate Canada-BC/YK Section's online registration is with the company Wufoo.com. All registrations must be completed using this online system.

Click here to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater. Coaches are encouraged to ask to see the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.
