Online registration must be completed by 11:45 PM Friday October 21, 2022

Entry in this competition is limited by the ice time available and priority will be given to Okanagan Region skaters. If there is insufficient ice time due to a large number of registrations, Individual and/or Group Showcase 1 & 2 events may be eliminated. In this case all registrants will be informed by Nov. 1, 2022 and their registration fee will be refunded.

**NOTE:** 48 hours following the closure of online registration, a list of all registrants will be posted on the Okanagan Region website and the Okanagan Interclub competition page of Skating in BC website. Everyone then has 48 hours to notify the Registrar of any changes. Beyond this time period, no changes will be permitted. This is to facilitate a faster turn-around time for the competition schedule to be published and for the Tech Rep to organize officials for the competition.

**\*For event requirements and specifications**, please refer to the 2022-2023 Skate Canada Podium Pathway and the 2022-2023 STAR Technical Requirements Guide, posted on the technical page of the <u>Skating in BC website</u>.

\*Note: 2022-2023 STAR Standards for Assessment Guide will be used for STAR 1-4 events.

\*\* Elements – Open will only be offered if there are not enough entries in Elements Star 6 and up. Do not enter this event online. Skaters will be informed if numbers warrant a change of category due to number of entries.

**\*\*\*Pre-Novice and Novice Events** – please note that any competitor/s who register in these event/s and subsequently *qualify for Challenge* will receive a full refund of their registration. *Refunds will not be given in any other circumstances.* 

**\*\*\*\*Synchronized Skating Events:** Registration fees are \$187.50 per team and \$20 per skaters. However, for this 2022-2023 season these registrations fees will be waived, in order to assist with development of this discipline in the Okanagan Region.

\*\*\*\*\* Artistic Entries; please note that the TIME each element begins must be included on the Planned Program sheet submitted during registration.

#### An additional \$7.50 per entry has been included to offset the costs of live streaming.

**Except for the \*\*\* refund policy above**, entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the request to withdraw is received before the closing date of entry. No refunds will be given after the close of entries (October 21, 2022) for any reason.

### LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LOC AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Friday October 21, 2022. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2022, and tests passed shall be as of October 21, 2022 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

For event requirements and specifications, please refer to the 2022-2023 Skate Canada Technical

**Program Requirements Guide for Podium Pathway and STAR, posted on the technical page on the Skating in BC website.** This includes the requirements for Elements, Showcase and Creative Improv events.

**INFO FOR PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS**: Please note that **STAR 5-Gold Freeskate**, **Artistic and Podium Pathway entries** must submit a completed Planned Program sheet as part of their registration. Please be sure to complete the form as part of the registration. The registration cannot be submitted for any the events listed above if the PPS is not completed. **Artistic entries must include the time that each element begins on the submitted planned program sheet**.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on <u>2022 Okanagan Interclub Competition</u> page of the Skating in BC website and on the Okanagan Region website <u>Skateokregion</u>. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled**.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. **BC/YK Section Safe Sport Policy:** Phone, video and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in a bag while in the dressing room.
- Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles and Artistic. If short and free programs are listed as separate events, skaters may enter one short program and one free program.
  Depending on scheduling, skaters should be prepared to skate two programs on the same day.
  Skaters choosing to enter more than one event do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that are unable to be resolved.
- 3. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Note that in BC/YK Section competitions, men and women will compete together in all STAR Events except free skating.
- 4. If an event has only one competitor or there is a last-minute withdrawal in an event that only had 2 entries, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. Skating for evaluation is only applicable to Podium Pathway and STAR Free Skate categories. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified for. If there is not enough ice time due to a large number of registrations, the Individual and/or Group Showcase 1 & 2 will be cancelled and competitors will be refunded after close of entries. Cancellation will be at the discretion of the LOC.
- 5. REGISTRATION: Skaters must register/check-in at least one hour before they are scheduled to skate. Please note that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled.
- 6. SIZE of WARM-UP GROUPS: The maximum number of skaters on warm-up for all STAR categories except STAR 1, will be 8.

\* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

- 8. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:
  - ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1 must submit music online as part of the Online Registration process.
  - Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file correctly marked and ready to load.
  - All MP3 files to be uploaded and must include the Skater's first name, last name, and the event the music is for in the file name. e.g. Sally Smith Star 5 U13.mp3. If the event is age specific that must also be included as in example above. Without all this information it is impossible for us to ensure the music links to the correct event.
  - Music files are **NOT** kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
  - All competitors must hand in their MUSIC BACKUP either on a USB memory stick or CD at the registration desk upon registering for the competition at least one hour prior to the start of their event. A USB memory stick **is preferred** but if submitting a CD, the following requirements must be met:
    - Only one program shall be recorded on the CD this is the same for the USB memory stick
    - The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in
    - Competitor's name followed by the music time (not skating time) shall be clearly marked on at least one side of the CD
    - Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also clearly marked with the skater's name, home club and event and total music time

No alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, MP3 players etc. will be accepted.

- 9. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information. *Please note that 2 coaches per skater will be permitted at the boards for the competition and warm up.*
- 10. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 11. AWARDS will be presented as soon as possible following the posting of results for each category.
- 12. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 13. <u>Protests: Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's

competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.

14. ASSESSMENTS: STAR Assessments will not be offered at this competition.

#### **Online Registration Instructions**

**Okanagan Region has an online registration system with the company Karelo.com.** All registrations must be completed using this online system. **To begin the process please visit the site listed below:**

### NEW: The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater's coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

#### Using Karelo for the first time

The first time you use Karelo.com to register for an event, you will be asked to choose a <u>log in name & a</u> <u>password</u>, and to enter your contact information. When entering contact information, please use the skater's name and not the parent's name. Skate Canada Number must be entered as per your Skate Canada Card (ie. 10 digits including all zeros). This is a very short and simple step that will enable you to avoid the hassle of re-entering your information for each event registration! Your contact information is never shared with third parties. Please review Karelo's <u>'Privacy Policy'</u> for more details.

#### **Entering your registration**

<u>If you have never used Karelo.com before</u>, go to '<u>I am new to Karelo.com</u>' and select a login name and a password; enter your contact information. Then follow these steps:

- 1. Log in. Select the event that you want to register for from the Event list.
- 2. Enter your registration information.
- 3. Enter your credit card information (Visa or MasterCard). This is a secure transaction. Your credit card is charged immediately.
- 4. You are registered! Check your email for the confirmation email with your registration details.

IMPORTANT: If you and your coach DO NOT receive an email confirmation from Karelo.com or receive a confirmation number, then you are NOT REGISTERED for the competition. Please contact the registrar if this occurs. REGISTRAR: Janet Gordon at gordonjm10@gmail.com
