RE: Challenge Quota of Entries for BC/YK Skaters and Minimum Technical Score Requirements

Challenge Quota of Entries

The BC/YK Section will advance the following number of skaters/teams in each discipline providing that qualifying skaters/teams meet the Challenge Minimum Qualifying Score.

2023 Skate Canada Jr/Sr Challenge-November 30-December 3, 2022-Winnipeg, MB

Senior Women: 5 entries

Senior Men: 4 entries

Senior Dance: 2 entries

Junior Women: 6 entries (5 normal quota plus one bye)

Junior Men: 6 entries (5 normal quota plus one bye)

Junior Dance: 1 entry

2023 Skate Canada PN/Nov Challenge-January 25-28, 2023-Regina, SK

Novice Women: 6 entries

Novice Men: 6 entries

Pre Novice Women: 6 entries

Pre Novice Men: 6 entries

Pre Novice Pairs: 2 entries

Pre Novice Dance: 1 entry

Challenge Minimum Scores (CMS)

Challenge Minimum scores were revised as follows as published on the Skate Canada Info Centre. The deadline to meet the score is November 13, 2022.

The CMS is the benchmark Technical Element Score (TES) for the free program that must be met or exceeded in order to enter Challenge. Note, that the CMS is the TES only and does not include bonuses or deductions.

Junior	35.5	35.5	23	20
Senior	44.5	40	34	36

Pre-Novice and Novice: The CMS must be met between July 1st of each season and the deadline date for entries to the Skate Canada Challenge.

Junior and Senior: The CMS must be met between July 1st of the preceding season and the deadline for entries to the Skate Canada Challenge.

The CMS must be met at the same or lower level of competition, and in the same discipline as that to be competed in at the Skate Canada Challenge. Any STARSkate free program score may also be used to meet the established CMS.

Registration information for skaters & coaches advancing to Pre Nov/Nov Challenge will be sent out by email in mid-December.
