2023-2024 assessment standards for STAR 1-4 will be used.

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (September 6, 2023) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER

**Single Entries:** All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YT Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation, or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to Podium Pathway categories and STAR Free Skating categories. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only.

One Club Entries: If <u>all</u> entries in a category are from the same club, the skaters and coaches will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Skaters must contact the BC/YT Section office within three business days to indicate if they wish to change categories or withdraw with a refund.

## All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

Online Registration must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, September 6, 2023. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 6 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2023; tests passed shall be as of September 6, 2023 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL FREE SKATE EVENTS EXCEPT STAR 2,3 & 4 MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2023. Click here to enter planned program information.

Note: there will be a \$25 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the October 4 deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>Autumn Leaves Competition Webpage</u> of the BC/YT Section website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.** 

#### Draws for Starting Order for the First Segment of an Event

The starting order for the first segment shall be randomly drawn by lot and will be posted on the <a href="https://www.skatinginbc.com">www.skatinginbc.com</a> website.

# **Draws for Starting Order for Subsequent Segments of an Event**

Competitors will be assigned to skate the subsequent segment in reverse order as per detail in <a href="Skate">Skate</a> Canada Rule Competitions 3.2 Draws, Reverse Order.

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. **BC/YT SAFESPORT POLICY**: Phone, video, and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in bags while in dressing rooms.
- Should entries in a category be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups
  determined by random draw. Each group will be considered a final. STAR groups will be divided
  according to age. Age categories may be combined when there are less than 6 entries in a
  category.
- 3. In BC/YT Section competitions, men and women will compete together in all STAR Events except STAR 4 to Gold free skating.
- 4. REGISTRATION: Skaters must register/check-in at least one hour before they are scheduled to skate. Please note that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled. More information regarding registration will be communicated closer to the competition.
- 5. SIZE of WARM-UP GROUPS: The maximum number of skaters on warm-up for all STAR categories, will be 8.
- 6. WARM-UP TIMES:

STAR 2 3 minutes
STAR 3, 4 & 5 4 minutes
STAR 6 to Gold Free Skate 5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior 6 minutes
Pattern Dance 3 minutes
Rhythm Dance/Free Dance 5 minutes

#### 7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL SKATERS must submit music online when they register.
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration
  process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to

- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- A backup USB flash drive (CDs will not be accepted) must be at the boards with the coach when the skater is competing.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted.
- 8. COACHES: To be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to be wearing their 2023/24 BC/YT Section Coach Card Accreditation and register in person at the competition. These Coach Card Accreditations can be purchased through the BC/YT Section Office and must be purchased at least 2 weeks prior to the competition. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25 per day by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.

<sup>\*</sup> At the discretion of the Referee, the warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

- 9. ADMISSION will be free to all. Information regarding spectator capacity will be communicated closer to the date of the event.
- 10. AWARDS: Information regarding awards will be communicated closer to the competition.
- 11. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 12. <u>Protests: Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> for competitions using CPC will be followed. If there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition, or to the Technical Representative if the Event Referee is unavailable.
- 13. ASSESSMENTS: Assessments will not be offered at this competition.

# **BC/YT SECTION Online Registration Instructions**

**Skate Canada-BC/YT Section's online registration is with the company Wufoo.com.** All registrations must be completed using this online system.

Click here to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater. Coaches are encouraged to ask to see the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.
