**Should it be necessary to eliminate entries due to a shortage of ice, events will be eliminated in the following order. Pre-Novice Short, Pre-Novice Free, Juvenile U14 and Juvenile U12.

Entry fees will be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (January 2, 2022) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE TECHNICAL REPRESENTATIVE UP TO 48 HOURS AFTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Sunday, January 2, 2022. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories, age will be the age of the skater before July 1, 2021 and assessments/tests passed will be as of January 2, 2022 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

For event requirements, please refer to the 2021-2022 Skate Canada Technical Requirements Guides for STAR posted on the <u>STAR Competition</u> of the <u>BC/YK Section Website</u>.

Planned program sheets for all artistic and short/free program events except STAR 1-4 must be submitted online to the BC Coast Region, Wufoo website, by January 17, 2022.

There will be a \$25 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the January 17th deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

Please note that the 2019-2020 assessment standards for STAR 1-4 will be used.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>competition page</u> of the BC/YK Section and on the <u>BC Coast Region</u> website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and communicated at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

NO assessments will be offered at this competition.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. We will be adhering to the BC/YK Section Vaccination Policy at this event, which can be found <u>HERE</u>.



- We are actively following the COVID-19 situation and information in this announcement may change at any time due to facility, regional, provincial and/or national restrictions or guidelines. Specific requirements will be posted on the BC/YK Section website and communicated to participants via email closer to the event.
- 3. BC/YK SAFESPORT POLICY: Phone, video and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in a bag while in the dressing room.
- 4. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in a category.
- 5. MARKING: STAR 1,2, 3 & 4 categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments/tests. All ribbons/medals will be provided to clubs for distribution. No awards ceremonies will take place at the competition.
- 6. Should there be only one entry in any event, the competitor may skate for an evaluation*, skate up one level, or withdraw and the entry fee will be refunded. If there is a last-minute withdrawal in an event that had only 2 entries, the same options apply for the remaining skater. *Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to competitive categories and STAR Free Skating Categories.

The warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes at the discretion of the Referee. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal

- 9. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:
 - ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1 must submit music online as part of the registration process.
 - All ice dancers using Skate Canada Contemporary Music selections, or their own selection of



pattern dance must also submit music electronically.

- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to Lori Oxland by clicking on the following link: <u>BC Coast Region</u>
- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Competitors must hand in their back up file either USB flash drive or DC at the registration desk at least one hour prior to when they are scheduled to skate. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB/CD.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
- Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
 - a. Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
 - b. Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.



- COACHES: In order to be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and have proof of coach registration & accreditation. Temporary accreditation will not be available. Only one coach per skater may be present at ice level.
- 11. ADMISSION will be free to all. Information regarding spectator capacity and vaccination status requirements will be communicated closer to the date of the event.
- 12. **SCOTT ROBERTS MEMORIAL TROPHY:** This trophy will be presented to the Artistic Winner in STAR 3. This award will be presented at the BC Coast Region AGM in April 2022. The winner will be notified the week following the competition.
- 13. **CAROL BLACKBURN MEMORIAL TROPHY:** This trophy will be presented to the winner in the Juvenile U14 Male and Female Categories. This award will be presented at the BC Coast Region AGM in April 2022. The winner will be notified the week following the competition. This award is sponsored by the Vancouver Skating Club.
- 14. Every effort will be made to secure a professional photographer for this event. All photography viewing & sales will occur online. Further information will be communicated closer to the event.

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.

- 15. Protests: <u>Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.
- 16. NO Assessments/tests will be offered at this competition.



WinterSkate Online Registration & Planned Program Instructions

The BC Coast Region uses an online registration system with the company <u>Wufoo.com</u>. All registrations must be completed using this online system. <u>Online Registration</u> to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater but not to the primary coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. THERE IS SOMETIMES A DELAY IN THE SYSTEM BEFORE YOU ARE TAKEN TO THE PAYMENT PAGE. YOU **MUST** WAIT TO MAKE PAYMENT OR YOU **WLL NOT** BE REGISTERED. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.

There are NO refunds given after the closing date of entry unless the event is cancelled.
