BC/YK 2014-2015 Elements Clarification

Some questions have arisen concerning requirements for element events particularly in regard to what "different" implies.

1. Spins must have a different spin code.

Example: If the spin performed as element #3 is a CCoSp, the skater may not perform another change combination spin as their element of choice for element #4.

2. Jump performed in #1 (the solo jump) may not be repeated.

Example: If in Elements 2, a skater performs a 2S as their double jump for element #1, they may not include a 2S as part of their jump combination for element #2 or for element #4, the element of skater's choice.

3. If the same jump is performed for the combo in #2 (ie, 2T+2T+C or 2Lo+2Lo+C) it may not be included in the jump combination in #4

Example: If a skater performs a 2T+2T+C for the jump combination, they cannot include a jump+2T in a jump combination for element #4, the element of the skater's choice.

As in competition, the same jump may not be seen more than twice.

4. The Jump combination skated as element #4 must be different than element #2.

Example: A 2F+2T+C will be considered different that 2Lz+2T+C and accepted so long as no other 2Ts are included in any other elements.
