LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE. All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

NEW: All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. (see General Information #3)

Online Registration must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, March 5th, 2014. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2013 and tests passed shall be as of March 5th, 2014 (closing date of entries). Please note that age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

some assistance please email support@coastregistry.com If your planned program does not need updating, you must still log in and select the Super Series Vancouver Island Competition so your planned program info is provided to the Technical Officials.

Deadline to submit changes to planned program sheets is April 2, 2014. Skaters arriving to compete who have not submitted a planned program sheet will be required to complete one when they register their music.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>Super Series Vancouver Island</u> <u>competition page</u> of the BC/YT Section website. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

TESTS: STARSkate Free Skate Part Two tests, Senior Bronze to Gold and Interpretive will be offered. Skaters must be registered to compete in the same event they are testing in. The exception is skaters competing in a competitive category who may also apply for Junior Silver, Senior Silver or Gold Free Skate Part Two. In this case, if the test is passed, the skater will receive credit for both Parts 1 and 2 of the test. As such, skaters will need to pay for both parts when registering, regardless of the outcome of the test. If a skater has already passed Part 1, they will not need to pay again. Deadline to receive test applications is Wednesday, April 26th, 2014. Refer to the Test Application form on the competition page for further information.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles, pairs, dance and interpretive. Junior and Senior Singles points will only count for Super Series standings if you enter both the short and free program.
- Should entries in a category be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups which will determined by random draw. STAR 1-3 groups will be divided according to age. Interpretive events will be divided by free skate test level first and then if further grouping is required, by age.
- 3. If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. When skating for an evaluation, feedback may be in the form of judges' comments only, if a technical panel is not available to assess technical content. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.
- 4. MARKING: STAR 2, 3 & 4 categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments. Special O categories will be judged using 6.0 marking system. All other categories will be marked using the CPC Scoring system.

5. REGISTRATION:

Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.

Dance events will be conducted in accordance with Skate Canada regulations.

7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- All skaters must submit an individual CD when they register. (exception: Pattern Dance)
- A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.
- Only CD's will be accepted. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- 8. ICE SURFACE: 80' x 200'
- 9. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
- 10. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 11. AWARDS: A notice will be posted in the arena with information regarding the time and location of medal presentations.
- 12. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.

^{*} At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

13. <u>Protest Policy:</u> Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6) (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.

BC/YT SECTION Online Registration Instructions

Skate Canada-BC/YT Section has an online registration system with the company Karelo.com. All registrations must be completed using this online system. Click here to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater's coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

Using Karelo for the first time

The first time you use Karelo.com to register for an event, you will be asked to choose a log in name & a password, and to enter your contact information. When entering contact information, please use the skater's name and not the parent's name. Skate Canada Number must be entered as per your Skate Canada Card (i.e. 10 digits including all zeros). This is a very short and simple step that will enable you to avoid the hassle of re-entering your information for each event registration! Your contact information is never shared with third parties. Please review Karelo's 'Privacy Policy' for more details.

Entering your registration

If you have never used Karelo.com before, go to 'I am new to Karelo.com' and select a login name and a password; enter your contact information. Then follow these steps:

- 1. Log in. Select the event that you want to register for from the Event List
- 2. Enter your registration information.
- 3. Enter your credit card information (Visa or MasterCard). This is a secure transaction. Your credit card is charged immediately.
- 4. You are registered! Check your email for the confirmation email with your registration details.

IMPORTANT: If you and your coach DO NOT receive an email confirmation from Karelo.com or receive a confirmation number, then you are NOT REGISTERED for the competition. Please contact the BC/YT Section Office if this occurs.
