EVENTS TO BE HELD & ENTRY INFORMATION

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LOC AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

Online Registration must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Monday, December 29, 2014. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement. Entry in this competition is limited to 550 entries due to the ice time available. Please enter early to avoid disappointment. For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2014 and tests passed shall be as of Monday, December 29, 2014 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

For Program Requirements, please refer to the 2014-2015 BC/YK Technical Packages posted on the Skating in BC website under Technical/STARSkate or Technical/Competitive Singles & Pairs

Planned program sheets for all free skate events <u>except</u> star 1,2,3 & 4 must be submitted online on the Coast Registry website by Monday, January 26th, 2015.

Important: Even if you have no changes to your planned program, you still must log in and select the WinterSkate Competition in the drop down menu. Click here for the Planned Program page of Coast Registry. If you have any questions or require some assistance please email support@coastregistry.com. Skaters arriving to compete who have not submitted a planned program sheet will be required to complete one when they register their music.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>competition page</u> of the BC/YT Section and on the <u>BC Coast Region</u> website. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**



GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles and interpretive. The total entry in this competition will be limited to 550 entries due to time and ice constraints.
- 2. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Region Champions will be determined on total points from each of the groups. If the entry in the competition has to be limited due to time and ice constraints the elimination will be done in this order: First elimination Pre-Novice Free Program, Second elimination Juvenile U14 events, Third elimination Juvenile U11 events.
- 3. If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.
- 4. MARKING: The CPC Scoring system will be used for all events with the exception of STAR 1, 2, 3 & 4. These categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments.
- 5. REGISTRATION: Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.
- 6. WARM UP TIMES:

STAR 2 3 minutes
STAR 3, 4, 5 4 minutes
Pre-Juvenile, Senior Bronze to Gold Free Skate 5 minutes
Juvenile and Pre-Novice 6 minutes
Interpretive 3 minutes
Special Olympics 6 minutes

* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

Dance warm-ups for Special O will be 30 seconds without music, followed by one full tune of the music.

7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1, must submit an individual CD when they
 register at the competition.
- Only CD's will be accepted. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD. THERE ARE TO BE NO LABELS OR STICKERS ON THE CD'S.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the



skater's performance.

- 8. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
- ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 10. AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.
- 11. There will be a photographer at this competition for action shots. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 12. <u>Protest Policy:</u> Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6) (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee.
- 13. TESTS: STARSkate Free Skate Part Two tests, Senior Bronze to Gold and Interpretive will be offered. Skaters must be registered to compete in the same event they are testing in. The exception is skaters competing in the Juvenile & Pre-Novice categories who may also apply for Junior Silver, Senior Silver or Gold Free Skate Part Two. In this case, if the test is passed, the skater will receive credit for both Parts 1 and 2 of the test. As such, skaters will need to pay for both parts when registering, regardless of the outcome of the test. If a skater has already passed Part 1, they will not need to pay again. Test Applications should be completed online by going to the Coast Registry website. Deadline for applications is January 23, 2015. Online Registration Instructions

WinterSkate Online Registration & Planned Program Instructions

The BC Coast Region is using a new online registration system with the company <u>Wufoo.com</u>. All registrations must be completed using this online system. <u>Online Registration</u> to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater and the primary coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is <u>not</u> necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.

Online Planned Program Instructions

- 1. go to http://www.coastregistry.com/CRCompetition.aspx?HostID=2&op=PlannedProgram
- 2. click on Submit your Planned Program
- 3. click Login or Create an Account box
- 4. click on Register now
- 5. create a user name and complete the registration information
- 6. click on Identify the Skater box
- 7. Enter information as requested on screen. Please make sure you are using standard name rules (capitalize first letter of each name only! Please do not use CAP Lock). Click OK The base skater profile is setup!
- 8. Click on Submit Planned Program box, using the drop down box to choose the event that the skater has been entered in. If the skater is entered in an event that only has one portion only a Free Program entry box will be available; if the skater is entered in an event that has both a short and a free skate program both boxes will be available.
- 9. Using the drop down options choose the elements that the skater is planning to execute. Do not click okay until both programs have been entered if your skater has both a short and a free skate program (but don't worry... if you did you were brought back to the original screen, just start the process again choosing your skater from the pop menu and choose Edit to bring the entry screen back up).
- 10. Once everything is entered click OK You're done!
