EVENTS TO BE HELD & ENTRY INFORMATION

Skaters may only enter one event at this competition. For example, if entering STAR 7 or 9, a skater may not enter STAR 8 or any other STAR category. Two-part competitive categories such as Pre-Novice Women are considered one event.

If there are time restraints due to large entry numbers, STAR 2 will be the first category to be cancelled. Skaters will be informed by Wednesday, September 18.

As with all Super Series events, an additional \$7.50 per entry has been added to offset the costs of live streaming.

For event requirements and specifications, please refer to the 2019-2020 Skate Canada Competitive Technical Requirements Guides and the STAR Technical Requirements Guide, posted on the Technical page of the <u>Skating in BC website</u>. For the 2019-2020 season, STAR 1-3 will continue to be assessed using Gold, Silver Bronze and Merit assessments.

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (September 11, 2019) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER

Single Entries: All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to competitive categories and STAR Free Skating categories. If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only.

One Club Entries: If <u>all</u> entries in a category are from the same club, the skaters and coaches will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Skaters must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate if they wish to change categories or withdraw with a refund.

All payments must be made online at the time of registration. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, September 11, 2019. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 6 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2019; tests passed shall be as of September 11, 2019 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL FREE SKATE EVENTS EXCEPT STAR 1,2,3 & 4 MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2019. <u>Click here</u> to enter planned program information.

Note: there will be a **\$25** fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the October 9 deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>Autumn Leaves competition page</u> of the BC/YK Section website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. Skaters entering dance categories the pattern dance draws will be the dances that are posted for Sectionals.
- 2. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in a category.

3. MARKING: STAR 1,2, 3 & 4 categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments. All other categories will be marked using the CPC Scoring system. For the 2019-2020 season, all STAR 1-3 events will continue to be assessed using Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Merit assessments.

4. REGISTRATION:

Skaters must register/check-in at least one hour before they are scheduled to skate.

5. WARM-UP TIMES:

STAR 2	3 minutes
STAR 3, 4 & 5	4 minutes
STAR 6 to Gold Free Skate	5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile	5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive	6 minutes
Pattern Dance & Solo Rhythm Dance	3 minutes
Rhythm/Free Dance	5 minutes

* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

6. SIZE OF WARM-UP GROUPS: In BC/YK competitions, the maximum number of skaters in warm up groups for STAR 2 to Gold Free Skate categories will be eight.

7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- All skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to Haley Adams at bcyksection@skatinginbc.com
- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Competitors must hand in their back up file either USB flash drive or CD at the registration desk at least one hour prior to when they are scheduled to skate. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB/CD.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
 - > Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
 - > The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
 - Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
 - Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event, and total music time.
- 8. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show

their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.

- 9. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 10. AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.
- 11. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 12. Protests: <u>Skate Canada Protest Rule</u> will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee.

BC/YK SECTION Online Registration Instructions

Skate Canada-BC/YK Section's online registration is with the company Wufoo.com. All registrations must be completed using this online system.

<u>Click here</u> to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater. Coaches are encouraged to ask to see the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.
