- Operating the music equipment
- Screen shots of the announcer module from the computer system will be reviewed
- Update / open forum discussion

At the conclusion of this training, you will be capable of volunteering as a music player or an announcer at any Regional Competition. Additionally, as a result of this training you will be invited to do a shift at the BC/YK SummerSkate Competition Thursday August 14th through 19th, 2014.
