GENERAL INFORMATION FOR SYNCHRO & ADULT

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (January 7, 2019) except in the case of one entry in an event. In this case, the team/skater will be notified and may withdraw with a full refund or skate for an evaluation. When skating for an evaluation no medals will be awarded. Each team will receive a report card for their skate and \$10.00 per skater will be refunded. Skating for evaluation in adult events is only applicable to free skating categories.

Skaters entering multiple disciplines or double teamers should be aware that there may be scheduling conflicts resulting in less than ideal scheduling, or that are unable to be resolved.

AGE: The age for all competitors in all events shall be the age before July 1, 2018. **For Synchro**, copies of birth certificates for all team members must be with the team manager during the competition in case of an age challenge.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: Skaters/teams must check-in at the competition registration desk at least one hour before they are scheduled to warm-up. Keep in mind that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled if the competition is running ahead of schedule.

WARM UP TIMES – Synchro: Warm-up periods will be allotted to all teams as follows: Each team shall be allowed one (1) minute of warm-up (without music) on the competition ice surface immediately prior to their performance. Warm-up time will begin from the moment the team is announced.

WARM UP TIMES - Adult

Free Skating 5 minutes Interpretive, Showcase 3 minutes

Dance 30 seconds without music followed by 2:30

minutes of pattern dance music

At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS: For all synchro and adult events planned program sheets must be submitted online on through Wufoo by **January 30, 2019.** There will be a \$20 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the January 30, 2019 deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- All teams and skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to Courtney Lott at bcyksection@skatinginbc.com
- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Teams and Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Teams and competitors must hand in their back up file either USB flash drive or CD at the registration desk at least one hour prior to when they are scheduled to skate. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB/CD.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
 - > Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
 - ➤ The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
 - > Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
 - ➤ Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the team or skater's name, home club, event, and total music time.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: A tentative schedule of events will be posted on the <u>competition page</u> of the BC/YK Section website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

COACHES: In order to be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and show proof of their 2018/19 Coach Card. Temporary accreditation will be issued for a fee of \$25.00, for failure to show your Coach Card, and by proving a current "In Good Standing" status on www.skatecanada.ca.

PRACTICE ICE – Adult: there will be no practice ice available.

ADMISSION: \$5.00 (6 years & under free) per day. Skate Canada members will be admitted free by showing a current membership card.

MEDALS: Will be awarded in all events with more than one entry in the competition.

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater/team.

PROTESTS: Skate Canada Protest rule for competitions using CPC will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the

completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.

There are no test requirements.

All teams will skate twice except for Beginner I and Beginner II who will skate once. Beginner teams will receive an assessment of Gold/Silver/ Bronze/Merit as in STAR 3.

Elementary teams will skate twice with only the second skate being assessed. Elementary teams will be assessed and ranked as in STAR 4.

Details for all categories can be found in the 2018-2019 Skate Canada SYS Technical Requirements Guide and the Synchronized Skating Learn to Train Event Management Guide posted on the Skating in BC website under <u>Technical Synchro</u>.

Additional medals can be purchased for alternates, coaches and the team manager at \$10/medal.

Birth certificates are not required when registering on-line. However, the Team Manager should carry a copy of all team members' birth certificates with them at all times in case of an age challenge.

PRACTICE ICE:

Novice: Minimum 10 minutes official practice on competition ice surface. Intermediate: Minimum 12 minutes official practice on competition ice surface. Open: Minimum 12 minutes official practice on competition ice surface.

Junior: Minimum 10 minutes official practice for short program and 12 minutes

for free program.

Senior: Minimum 10 minutes official practice for short program and 15 minutes

for free program.

There will be no other practice ice available.

ADULT

Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

Should there be time restraints, entry fees will be refunded for cancelled events. Events will be cancelled in the following order: Showcase, Solo Dance.

BC/YK SECTION ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

All payments must be made online at the time of registration. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

Online registration must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Monday, January 7, 2019.

Skate Canada-BC/YK Section's online registration system is with the company <u>Wufoo.com</u>. All registrations must be completed using this online system.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". Please note that it is <u>not</u> necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.
