Highlighting the competition were our BC men who swept the podium in the Senior Men's Event along with Julianne Delaurier who was crowned Canadian Champion in the Pre-Novice Ladies event.

In total, BC brought home three gold, four silver, six bronze medals and ten additional top ten finishes.




In addition to the valuable information that they received from each other, coaches also had the opportunity to listen to guest speakers, Richard Gauthier and Julie Mar-




